Quality:	Quality Wine (=Qualitätswein)

Origin:	Eisenberg Region, Burgenland
Site:	Neuhaus-Hochäcker, heavy loamy soil rich in iron minerals and dry slate provide ideal conditions for that variety
Age of vines:	15 years
Winemaking:	After de-stemming and crushing the must is traditionally fermented in steel tanks, after 10 days carefully pressed. After malolactic secondary fermentation in steel tanks aging for 12 months in large oak barrels before bottling
Closure:	Cork
Wine description:	Dark ruby red with purple reflects. This wine reveals aromas of dark berries and light wooden flavor. Juicy fruit of cherry and blackthorn, mineralic yet tender with a pleasant tannic characteristic. Medium finish
Drink recommendation:	Serve at 17-18 °C.
Food pairing:	Matches well with starters, main courses of red and white meat and a wide variety of chocolate desserts or cheese.

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
